Senator Bill Bradley

Senator Bill Bradley is recognized as one of the leading experts in the field of public policy issues affecting college and professional sports. He served three terms as a Democratic U.S. Senator from New Jersey and was a Rhodes Scholar. In addition, Bill Bradley is an accomplished basketball player. He was an All-American at Princeton and spent ten years playing for the New York Knicks in the NBA.

Sen. Bill Bradley also has ties to the University of Kentucky. On December 21, 1963, Princeton forward Bill Bradley set an all-time University of Kentucky Invitational Tournament single-game scoring record of 47 points in a 90-87 victory over Wisconsin.

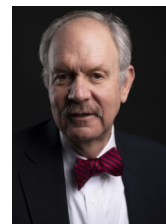
