Dr. John Postlethwait is an evolutionary geneticist focusing on animal development and sex determination who has received many awards and honors over the course of his career. Most recently, in 2015 he received the George W. Beadle Award from the Genetics Society of America, and in 2016 he received the University of Oregon Outstanding Career Award for Research Excellence. He is a member of the Institute of Neuroscience at the University of Oregon and has been a visiting professor and research scientist at several international universities, including the Austrian Academy of Sciences in Salzburg, Austria and the Imperial Cancer Research Fund at Oxford University.
